Presentation	Keynote (iOS, \$) Haiku Deck (iOS) SlideRocket	Create and show presentations on the go. Plug in projector to start presentation.
Taking Notes	Evernote OneNote Simplenote Catch	Create notes using voice, photo, and text.
Annotating Documents	Adobe Reader iAnnotate PDF GoodReader (iOS, \$) Notability (iOS, \$)	Read and annotate PDFs and other digital formats with ease.
Whiteboards	ScreenChomp (iOS) Educreations (iOS) Whiteboard (Android)	Instead of just sharing your ideas, you can show them with these apps. White board allows for free-hand drawing that can be quickly shared.
Research	Genius Scan RefWorks (web app) Mendeley (iOS)	Quickly scan and save citations of printed books. Manage and organize your bibliography on the go.
Professional Networking	LinkedIn Twitter	Keep up with latest news and trends from professionals in your field.
Polling & Attendance	Socrative Attendance2 (iOS) Attendance Tracker (Android)	Take class attendance. Engage your students via live polling.
